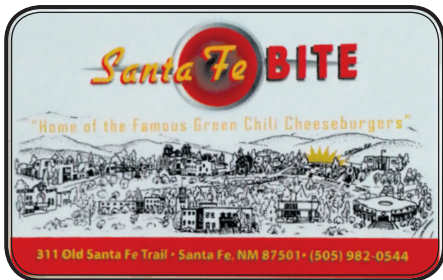

Gaymus, Cabernet Sauvignon,

2011, Rutherford, CA\$110/bottle only

On the palate, this Cabernet is rich with sweet, ripe tannins, expanding to a greater breadth of refined textures. The flavor profile includes dark chocolate, sweet tobacco, mocha, leather, brown spice, cedar, vanilla and sweet licorice. The stand out qualities of this wine are its balance, supple texture, approachable grip and earthy notes.

Hoopla, The Mutt, Pure Napa Valley Red Wine,

2011, Napa Valley, CA\$46/bottle only

On the nose are supple notes of blackberries and coriander. The Cabernet and Merlot blend delivers plenty of fruit framed by aging in oak barrels providing a long and lush finish.

King Estate, Signature, Pinot Noir,

2011, Oregon\$30/half bottle only

Dark ruby and garnet colors. Aromas of toast, oak, black cherry, baking spice, leather, pomegranate, grapefruit, raspberry, eucalyptus, tobacco leaf, toasted cherry flavors, with a touch of citrus. Soft tannins, a viscous mouthfeel, lingering fruit and a medium-long finish.

Conundrum, White Blend, 2012, Rutherford, CA\$8/\$38

Delicious blend of five white wine grapes is one of the best of its type from California. It's a complex wine, with an array of ripe, concentrated flavors — pear, honey, fig, vanilla, peach and nectarine, finishing with lots of character and a dash of spice.

King Estate, Acrobat Pinot Gris, 2012, Oregon\$7/\$33

A translucent, pale straw color. Rich citrus aromas, tropical papaya, pineapple and lychee unfold, with hints of limestone and honeysuckle floral notes. Lemon and lime ripeness on entry, evolving with honeydew melon, golden delicious apple mid-palate, and lingering with notes of kiwi. Light and well-balanced entry, full mid-palate, with a crisp lingering finish.

Petrano Estate Vinyards, Chardonnay, 2012,

The Herigate Collection, Lodi\$8/\$38

The aromas of vanilla, lemon meringue pie, and tangerines are complemented by hints of buttery notes entice a sip. The mouth fills with tropical fruit, homemade lemon pie and vanilla, which round out the wine and leave a lingering finish.

Conundrum, Red Blend, 2011, Rutherford, CA \$8/\$38

Lots of red fruit up front. Interwoven bright and bold cherries, soft tannins and a tiny hint of sweetness on the back of the palate gives it a long memorable finish of lush velvety black fruit. The finish is long and not drying of tannins; beckons a second sip.

Barricas, Malbec, 2012, Mendoza, Argentina \$6/\$28

Vivid purple varietal wine that is round and medium bodied with boysenberry and cherry aromas, and hints of violet and vanilla. Fine tannin notes and a charming finish.

Easton, Zinfandel, 2011, Amador County, CA\$7/\$33

Floral, sleek and elegant, with aromas of raspberry and riverbed rock, offering supple, balanced cherry and spicy fennel flavors that linger on the finish with a nice creamy texture.
